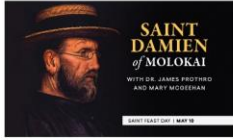




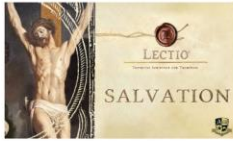

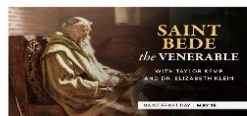
### Saint Philip Neri: I Prefer Heaven
